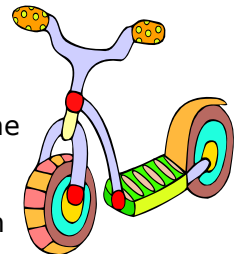

Summer Camp Information

Special Instructions for field trips

Lunch at school- We will eat at school either before or after the trip. You can order from the office or bring from home.

Pay for Lunch in office-We will be eating lunch purchased on the field trip. Pay for lunch in the office. If there is a choice we will ask your child for their preference. Most of the time these places will not let us bring our own food.

Bring Lunch – We will be eating lunch on the field trip and you need to send their lunch and drink with them.

\$\$\$- I've noted on the calendar which field trips you can send extra cash. It is **not** required.

Please wear your blue shirt on field trips. This **is required.** If your child forgets, they will be given a school shirt and your account will be charged \$10.00. This is for the safety of your child.

Shoes-We encourage your child to wear tennis shoes (or shoes that cover their feet) on field trip days.

Other Information

Toys-Children are welcome to bring their toys from home to class. Toys are not allowed on field trips. They will be left in the classrooms. We will do our best to help your child keep up with their things-but we are not responsible for anything lost, stolen or broken.

Ratings-We play only G and PG movies. Video games must be rated E or Teen. Nothing higher. Some Teen games may not be acceptable.

Splash Days- Please bring a towel, swimsuit and water shoes or flip flops. You may wear your swimsuit under your clothes, just make sure you have all you need to change after you play in the water. Splash days are on Wednesdays, but not every week. Check your calendar. Also, some of our field trips this summer will include splash times. Again, check your calendar.

Scooters- Scooter Days are Monday. Tennis shoes **must** be worn to participate. Scooters can be left all summer (in room 113) or brought on scooter days.

Reward Store-Students will earn 20 points each day they attend. The points are for reading and good behavior. Points can be taken away for bad behavior or attitudes. Extra points can be earned for learning this summer's Bible verses and when the teacher offers them-usually for chores. Your child can also earn extra points by reading a book at home. You must send a note if they do this. The number of extra points is decided by the teacher. Points are spent once a week (Wednesday) at the reward store. The reward store has new or used/donated items and candy. If you want to contribute it would be appreciated.

Special Food Days-Occasionally you will to bring an item of food from a sign up list. Special food days usually are on Thursdays.

How To Find Us

Your child will start the day in room 133. (8:00-8:30 girls/ 8:00-9:30 boys)

If you need to bring your child before 8:00 check with the office for room location.

The boys will end the day in 133 (4-6pm)and the girls end the day in 301(4-5:30pm) and 133 (5:30-6pm).

They eat snacks and lunch in room 302.(9:30-10:00,12:00-1:00 and 3:30-4:00)

Some eating times will be adjusted on Field trip days.

The rest of the day they use classrooms 301(girls) and 303(boys).

They play in the Gym, the Soccer Field, the Breezeway and occasionally the Playground.

If you see a red flag that means there is no one in rooms 301, 302 or 303.

Check with the office if you can't find us.
